Rick Holdsworth, Clinician

Rick Holdsworth has dedicated his career to sharing music with the public, as a vocalist, instrumentalist, director, arranger, and music educator. His love of music began at an early age and grew as a member of his high school marching band. After graduation, he began his first professional music career in the U.S. Navy. During his 30 years of service, Rick performed in, managed, and directed Navy bands around the world. After retiring as a master chief, he began his second career in music ministry. For more than 20 years now, Rick has been leading an extensive music ministry, including vocal and handbell choirs of all ages and skill levels, as the Director of Music at Pine Shores Presbyterian Church in Sarasota, Florida.



A recognized expert in all facets of handbell music and operations, Rick has been an enthusiastic member of the handbell music community for nearly four decades. In 2009, Rick founded Ring Sarasota – an advanced handbell community ensemble – and continues to lead the organization as principal conductor. He has been an invited guest conductor and clinician at handbell conferences and festivals throughout the southeast and has published handbell arrangements and orchestrations with five different music publishers to date. His first handbell arrangement, a complete transcription of "Jupiter" from The Planets, was published by From the Top Music and selected for performance at Distinctly Bronze East 2015 – an event he has participated in for a decade.

Rick is an active member of the American Guild of Organists Sarasota-Manatee Chapter, the Handbell Musicians of America, the Presbyterian Association of Musicians, and the Fellowship of Methodist Musicians. When not creating handbell music, he works behind the scenes as the Florida Handbell Doctor repairing, adjusting, refurbishing, and cleaning handbell sets for organizations throughout the southeast.

Rick is married to Cher, and they have three grown children and five grandchildren. In his spare time, he can be found tinkering with his Lionel O-Gauge model train layout.

Alan Lohr, Clinician

Alan Lohr has been an adjunct faculty member at Bob Jones University since 1989 and has also worked at SoundForth music division of BJU Press until 2012 when SoundForth was sold to The Lorenz Corporation based in Dayton Ohio. There he was the keyboard and handbell editor for the SoundForth imprint. As the director of the handbell choirs at the BJU, Mr. Lohr has been active as a clinician and adjudicator for various national and state competitions. He has led his choir in recitals, concerts, and toured throughout the United States representing BJU in churches and schools. He has taught at many conferences utilizing the music notation program, Finale, to students and music directors.



Mr. Lohr earned his undergraduate degree in Music Education and his MA in Sacred Music from Bob Jones University. He has also studied at Rollins College in Winter Park, Florida, and the University of South Carolina in Columbia. He studied handbells with Don Allured at the Hartt School of Music in Hartford, Connecticut. He has been an active member of the Handbell Musicians of America and served on the Area 4 board in various positions and also on the board of the Handbell Industry Council.

He is the current director and founding member of Carolina Bronze, a community handbell choir in Greenville, South Carolina established in 2000.

He and his wife, Nancy, are retired. They have one married daughter and three grandchildren. He enjoys gardening, traveling, and spending time with his wife and family.

Festival Information

On-Site Check-in & Set-up

Set-up and check-in is between 10:00am and 1:00pm on Friday. If you have your own tables, you are encouraged to bring them. Table rental fees are on the registration form. You should also bring foam, covers and any equipment needed for ringing. Food and drinks are not allowed on the tables. Drinks should be capped, spill proof, and kept beneath the tables.

Orphans & Orphan Hosts

We will try to place orphans in your desired ringing position or as close as possible in a 'host' choir. Please mark orphan on the registration form. Please do not opt out of bringing your own equipment for convenience as orphan placement is limited. Choirs who are bringing equipment and have some positions open for orphans, please indicate those positions on the registration page.

Youth

Youth choirs are welcome to participate in the festival at the proper level of their ability. Underage participants (17 and younger) must be chaperoned (one adult, 21 years and older, per 6 ringers under the age of 17). Non-ringing chaperones may register as a guest for \$35. Ringing chaperones must register as a ringer. A notarized medical release form is required for underage participants (see page 11).

Bronze Choir

This group is for individuals or groups who would like to ring additional advanced music. Participating requires you to purchase additional music and prepare it before arriving at the festival. There will be additional rehearsals and **you must attend all rehearsals** to participate in the Bronze Choir. Fill out the Bronze Choir registration form on page 10 and complete your registration by January 1, 2024. This choir will require a minimum number of ringers.

Refunds

There is a non-refundable \$25 administration fee charged on all refunds requested before February 1, 2024. No refunds will be given after February 1, 2024, but you may transfer the registration to another ringer.

Classes

A description of classes with instructors and schedule will be available on our website in January, 2024.

Dress

Dress casual, wear comfortable shoes and layer for AC. Please no cologne/perfumes as your neighbor may have allergies. No special dress is required for the concert but matching shirts or outfits are encouraged.

Festival Information Continued

Meals

We will be providing dinner on Friday night and breakfast and lunch on Saturday. Snacks and beverages will be available during the festival. If you need vegetarian meals, you must order them for the entire event.

Lunch on Friday can be pre-ordered for an additional \$10.00 per person.

Lodging

Warren Willis Camp Location: The rooms offered at the Conference Center are single or double occupancy. Linens and towels are provided. These are hotel style rooms with twin beds but do not have televisions. If you live outside of a 60 mile radius of the venue and don't stay at the Conference Center there is a \$20 charge per person to subsidize the venue costs.

Vero Beach Location: A hotel list will be made available soon. You will be emailed the hotel block details after registration.

Lighting

The lighting in the ringing room may not be the same in all areas. Please feel free to bring a music light if you prefer.

Music

You must purchase and prepare the music before attending. The conductor will focus on the musicality of the pieces instead of notes and rhythms.

No photocopies of the music allowed. If you use an electronic device you must have written permission from the publisher per the Handbell Musician guidelines (<u>Click here</u> for electronic music guidelines).

Payment and Registration Options
